



## **Bulletin 1.2 – Current SROC Covid-19 Event arrangements**

(This Bulletin supersedes the published event SR's.)

- 1) If you are attending an event you can only be on site as a pre-booked competitor or official. There will be NO SPECTATORS and NO PAY ON THE DAY.
- 2) Anyone (re)joining will need to do so 14 days prior to the entry closing date.
- 3) Anyone camping must have pre-booked, naming all members of their party, on the club website [www.sroc.co.uk/camping-booking](http://www.sroc.co.uk/camping-booking). Social distancing to be practised at all times.
- 4) If you are competing you will have to enter on line before the event closing date. You will then be sent a Motorsport UK Covid-19 Competitor Signing on form that you will need to complete and return. Your entry will not be complete until you have done so. There will be a maximum of two passengers per entrant who will also need to complete the same signing on form.
- 5) Double drives are permitted so long as the vehicle has all hard surfaces used by the driver & any passenger are wiped down by the preceding occupants ready for the next although cohabitating double drivers are exempt from this. Any sanitiser / PPE to be supplied by the competitors.
- 6) Any passengers that do not live with the driver will require both the driver and the passenger to wear a face mask. There are NO exemptions to this, even if you have a medical reason why you can't wear one.
- 7) If you are coming along to Officiate / help run the event you will also need to pre book online and fill in a Motorsport UK Covid-19 Officials Signing on form. These are available on the relevant page for the event on the website and once completed should be returned to [eventstaffing@sroc.co.uk](mailto:eventstaffing@sroc.co.uk). If there is a specific job you would like to do, please contact the Event Staffing secretary to request that position, if it is available.
- 8) On arriving at the site competitors will be required to show their current membership card and Motorsport UK License which must be the minimum of an RS Clubman.
- 9) All competitors and officials will need to be on site by 9.30am as the gates will be locked at this time.
- 10) Scrutineering will be as socially distant at the start of the event, with closer attention being paid throughout the day as required.
- 11) Officials will need to make their own way around the site, either by their own suitable vehicle or walking. They cannot "hitch a lift" with others unless they cohabit with everyone else in the vehicle, or all occupants of the vehicle wear PPE, or they ride in the load space of a truck cab vehicle with the rear window closed.
- 12) Marshals will be static on section and "placed" by the clerk.
- 13) The course furniture can only be touched by the Clerk of the Course or any other official wearing at least PPE gloves.
- 14) Scoring will be done by the Start Marshal on the Master Score Sheet only. Competitor score cards will not be used.
- 15) At the end of the days competition everyone will return to the pits field and the gate unlocked, where they will be able to load up as required and leave.
- 16) There will be no prize giving. The event results will be posted on the website as soon as is practicable after the event.
- 17) Competitors can only move to the Camping field if they have pre-booked as camping were applicable, and then only to their own unit.
- 18) A small quantity of PPE is available for officials as required. Any competitors will need to provide their own.

Anyone who is not pre booked will not be allowed access to the site.

Any breaking of the regulations and you will be politely asked to leave with no refund.
